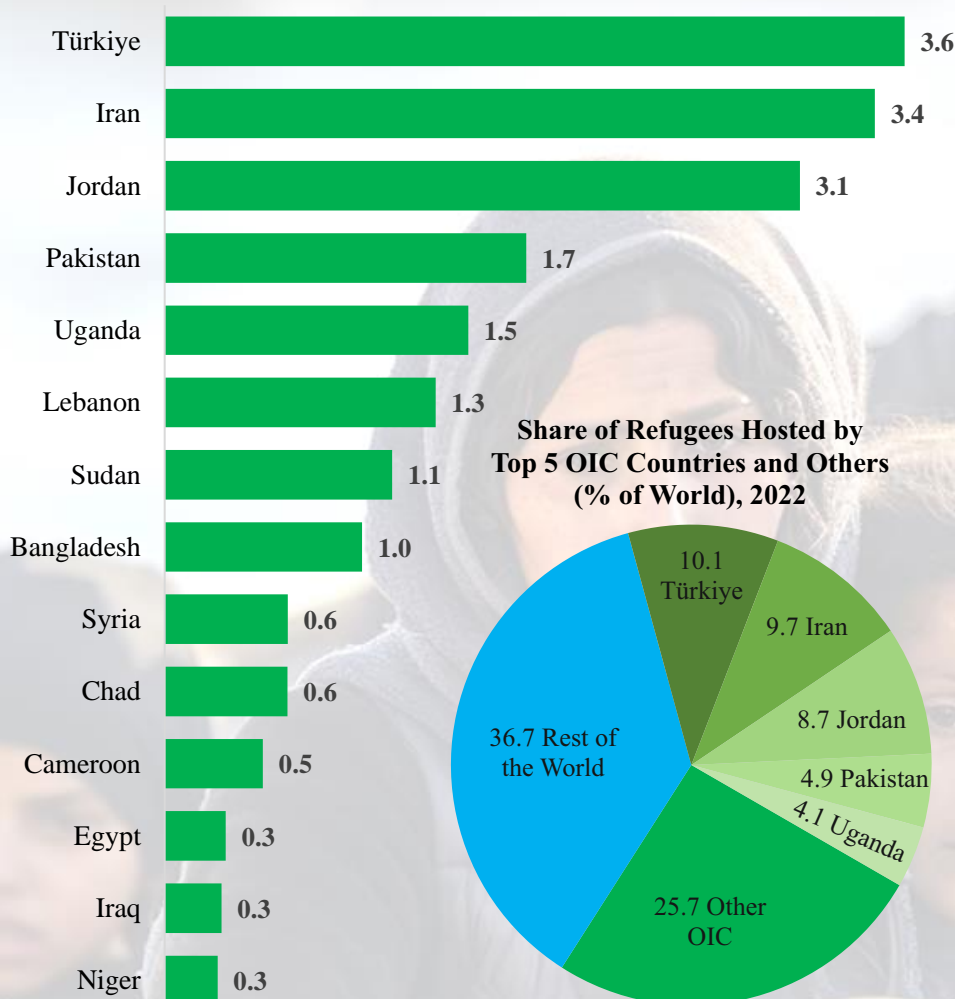
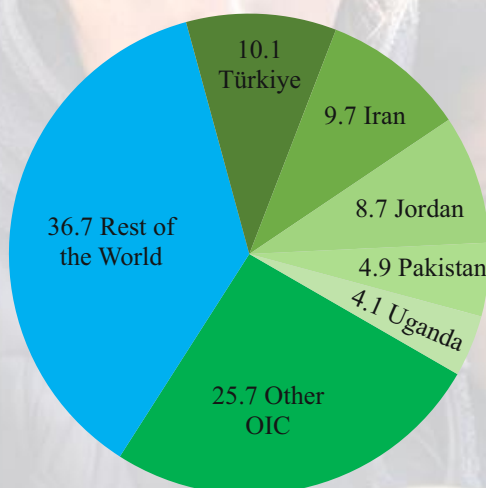


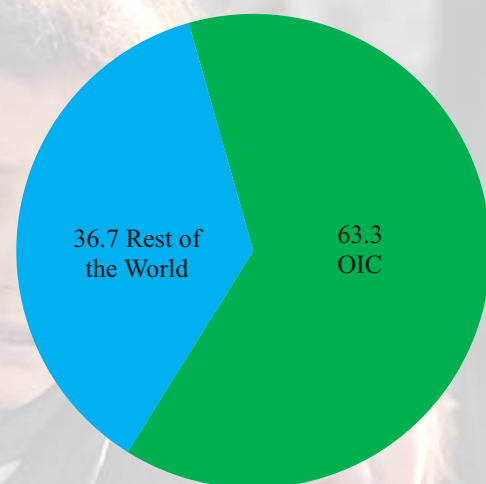
## Number of Refugees Hosted by OIC Countries (Million), 2022

- OIC countries bear the greatest responsibility for hosting the world's displaced population.
- In 2022, OIC countries hosted **63%** of the world's total **35 million refugees**.
- **Türkiye** is the largest host country in the world, hosting **3.6** million refugees, which will account for **10%** of the world's refugees.
- **Iran** and **Jordan** are the second and third largest refugee-hosting countries in the world, respectively. These 3 OIC countries account for **28%** of the world's total refugees.
- Among the OIC countries, **Pakistan** and **Uganda** are also notable hosts, accommodating **1.7** million and **1.5** million refugees respectively.
- Despite being significantly affected by conflicts themselves, OIC countries like Sudan continue to host large numbers of refugees. Sudan hosts over **1.1** million refugees, highlighting the ongoing challenges and resilience within the region.
- Unfortunately, conflicts have continued to be a challenge for OIC countries in terms of number of victims, refugees, and displaced persons. Inadequate response mechanisms, lack of risk assessment and early warning, and absence of a coordinated recovery program can lead to long-term development lags.
