- Classification of the Functions of Government (COFOG) was developed by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development and published by the United Nations Statistical Division.
- COFOG classifies government expenditure data from the System of National Accounts by the purpose for which the funds are used.
- COFOG divided into three levels: Divisions, Groups, and Classes.

Class – four digit level

THE FUNCTION OF COFOR



- 1. Used for making international comparisons of the extent to which governments are involved in particular economic and social function
- 2. For the analysis purposes, COFOG provides key aggregates that could be used as indicator or measures the result. Eg: study on the impact of economic growth on the environment may require information on the expenditure on environment protection.

THE FUNCTION OF COFOR



 Government services can benefit the community either individual or collectively. COFOG is used to distinguish between individual and collective services provided by general government (SNA 2008)

Predominantly collective consumption (a collective consumption service is a service provided simultaneously to all members of the community or to all members of a particular section of the community, such as all households living in a particular region)


