Tobacco Questions for Surveys (TQS)

was developed with a view to incorporating the globally standardized tobacco questions into the ongoing national and international surveys.

Subset of key questions from the Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS)

meant to improve comparability of tobacco data over time by harmonizing tobacco surveillance activities across various ongoing surveys.



Article 20 and Article 21 of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC)

emphasizes that essential component of a comprehensive global tobacco control effort is an efficient and systematic surveillance mechanism to monitor the epidemic.

Component of Global Tobacco Surveillance System (GTSS)

developed by WHO, CDC, and other partners, to assist countries in establishing tobacco control surveillance and monitoring programs.

OIC Strategic Health Programme of Action for 2014-2023

recommends for reducing the level of exposure of the populations in the OIC member countries to the harmful effects of tobacco.

Resolution of 4th Session of OIC Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom) held in April 2014

included the importance of public health issues and tobacco control.



SESRIC signed a Memorandum of Agreement with the CDC Foundation

- *on 12 September 2014.*
- *to encourage the integration of TQS questions into the ongoing national surveys in OIC member countries.*
- *included TQS-Youth in 2019.*

TQS integration into ongoing surveys

will serve as a mechanism to harmonize and standardize the monitoring of key tobacco control indicators, and promote sustainability and integration with other risk factors surveillance initiatives.

CDC and CDC Foundation indicated the OIC countries to be approached for the integration of TQS or TQS-Youth into their ongoing surveys

SESRIC approaches the selected countries

The countries are expected to ensure the continuation of TQS and TQS-Youth data collection in accordance with the frequency of the relevant survey






TQS Report on “Implementation of the Tobacco Questions for Surveys (TQS) in Selected OIC Member Countries: Evidence for Action”



Findings from TQS in Selected Member Countries of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation, 2015-19

Adults who currently smoke tobacco:



At least 1 in 5 adults were exposed to secondhand smoke at home:



At least 1 in 3 adults who smoked thought about quitting because of graphic health warning labels in eight countries.

Clothing with a cigarette brand name or logo were the most noticed form of tobacco promotion in eight countries.



About half of adults who smoked tobacco tried to quit:










Au moins 1 adulte sur 3 qui fumait a pensé à arrêter de fumer à cause des mises en garde sanitaires visuelles dans huit pays.

Les vêtements avec une marque ou un logo de cigarette étaient la forme de promotion du tabac la plus remarquée dans huit pays.




