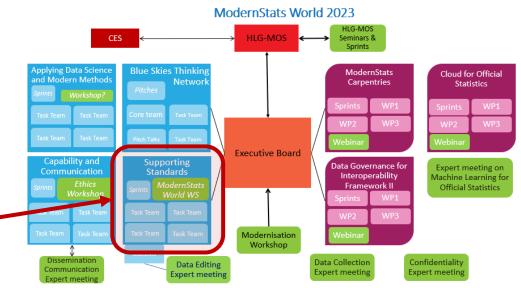




HLG-MOS and Supporting Standards Group

 Supporting Standards Group is one of four HLG-MOS Modernisations Groups











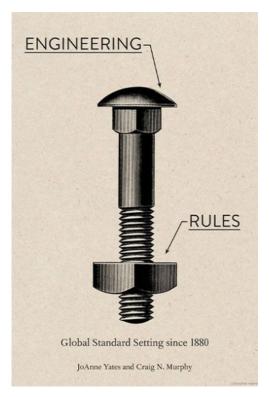

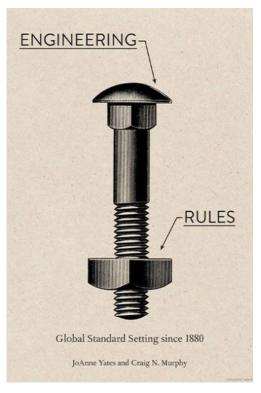

- Standardisation of the way we work can amplify the benefits of technical innovations

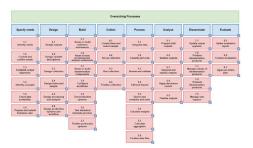

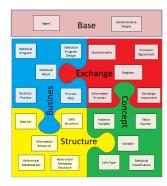
GSBPM – Activities related to statistical production **process**

GSIM – **Information** inputs and outputs for the production process









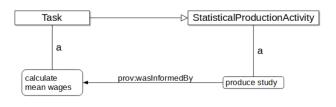

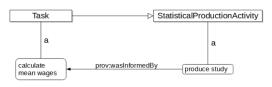






- Developed by statistical organisations, for statistical organisations
