



# Workshop on “Generic Models of Statistical Production”

## 1 Background and Objectives

Under the guidance of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) High-Level Group for the Modernisation of Official Statistics (HLG-MOS), several statistical production and architectural models have been developed to support the modernization of official statistics. These models, referred to as “ModernStats models”, consist of Generic Activity Model for Statistical Organizations (GAMSO), Generic Statistical Business Process Model (GSBPM), Generic Statistical Information Model (GSIM), and Common Statistical Production Architecture (CSPA). Other models, including Common Statistical Data Architecture (CSDA), Logical Information Model (LIM), and Modernisation Maturity Model (MMM), also play a role in supporting the ModernStats models. However, the implementation of these models varies between statistical organisations, with some still in the early stages of adaptation/implementation, some using only one, and others using multiple models.

In line with the Strategic Area 3 “Statistical Modernisation and Innovation” of the OIC Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom) Programme of Action 2021-2025, SESRIC – in its capacity as the Secretariat of OIC-StatCom – will organise a Workshop on “Generic Models of Statistical Production” virtually in collaboration with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) on 10-11 July 2023 to provide an overview of ModernStats and other models, and to facilitate sharing and exchange of experiences among OIC member countries in implementing the ModernStats and/or other models.

The Workshop will cover the following topics:

- An Overview of ModernStats (GAMSO, GSBPM, and GSIM) and Other Related Models;
- Survey Results on the Use of ModernStats Models in OIC Member Countries;
- Country Experiences and Challenges in Implementing ModernStats and Other Models; and
- Opportunities for Cooperation Activities and Way Forward

## 2 Target Audience

The target audience of the Workshop includes the staff of National Statistical Offices (NSOs) of OIC member countries who are responsible for developing/adapting, implementing, and promoting standards-based statistical modernisation, as well as those who are using or considering using these models for modernising their statistical production processes.

- The Workshop will be held virtually through the Zoom platform on 10-11 July 2023, with around 3 hours each day with presentations and discussions.
- There will be Q&A at the end of each session.
