### **BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES**

A comprehensive, reliable and up-to-date statistical information base is essential for sound decisionmaking processes in any society. To cater for such a need of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Member Countries, the Statistical, Economic and Social Research and Training Centre for Islamic Countries (SESRIC) has been established as a subsidiary organ of the OIC with a multifaceted mandate that includes, in particular, the compilation, processing and dissemination of up-todate and reliable information and statistics on the major social and economic indicators in the Member Countries.

Since its establishment in 1978, SESRIC has been making strenuous efforts to fulfil this specific task at the highest possible level through the publication of various statistical volumes and series both in hard cover and on its website. As a continuation of these efforts, the 2023 edition of the flagship report **"Statistical Yearbook on OIC Member Countries"** will be launched on 26 September 2024. The Yearbook serves as a primary tool and an indispensable reference for decision-makers, researchers, and analysts. This year's report presents 251 selected socio-economic statistical indicators under 22 categories, generally spanning from 2000 to 2022. The report provides both individual country data and aggregated group data of the OIC, with performance metrics compared to global averages.

In addition to launching the Yearbook, SESRIC will also unveil the new version of the **OIC Statistics Database (OICStat)**, which stands as the premier resource for comprehensive statistical information on all 57 OIC countries. Available in Arabic, English, and French, OICStat offers a rich array of data with over 1,800 indicators across 27 categories, dating back to 1970. The database, designed for ease of use, is freely accessible through the SESRIC website. Recognized as an invaluable tool for decision-makers, researchers, and analysts, OICStat's continuous enhancement is critical. By expanding its content, SESRIC aims to support the collective efforts to elevate cooperation among OIC countries in diverse socio-economic domains.

The launch event will also host panel discussions. The panel discussions, titled "Strengthening the Role of Data for Policy Making", will include representatives from relevant international institutions, focusing on the importance of data in policymaking across various sectors.

With the launch event of the Statistical Yearbook of OIC Member Countries 2023 and the new version of the OICStat, SESRIC aims to present both the comprehensive annual report and its accompanying database to its stakeholders. This event serves as a platform to disseminate the latest statistical information and developments, fostering dialogue and gathering valuable perspectives. By facilitating this engagement, SESRIC reaffirms its commitment to enhancing statistical capacity and advancing sustainable development across the OIC region. This initiative underscores
