OIC-STATCOM



- OIC-StatCom holds its annual sessions since 2011 to discuss issues of common interest and contribute to the efforts of its member countries to improve their statistical capacities by sharing best practices and experiences.
- Resolutions of the OIC-StatCom shape the activities of the statistical activities of SESRIC.



STATCAB

Statistical Capacity Building (STATCAB) Programme

- Flagship capacity building programme since 2007
- Based on South-South Cooperation approach
- NSOs communicate their needs and capacities in the area of statistics through questionnaires for conduct of activities





- SESRIC also engages with the international organisations to bring about a synergy for the benefit of the NSSs of OIC Member Countries.
- MoUs signed: AFRISTAT, CDC-F, ILO, ISESCO, UNWTO, and World Bank




To increase awareness on various statistical core skills frameworks, certification and accreditation systems

CERTIFICATION


• examines the **CONFORMITY** with a set of clearly defined and expected requirements






