



The OIC-CPOS project basically aims at certifying the expertise and knowledge on the professional conduct of statistical work by official statistics professionals in the OIC Member Countries. The project further aims at recognizing those who have achieved an acceptable level of professional competence in the understanding and application of statistical methods and are bound by code of ethics, principles and good practices of Official Statistics.

- · Specifying the themes of the certification examinations;
- Approving the official curricula, structure, timetable, admission criteria, and training materials of the certification examinations; and
- Announcing the candidates who pass the certification examinations.

Organisational and Professional Benefits

The global development agenda for the periods 2000-2015 and 2016-2030 has highlighted the significance of high-quality official statistics for decision-making at both the national and global levels. Consequently, the number of job postings related to official statistics is increasing. In connection, certifications are central to pave the way to a successful career. The OIC-CPOS Certification is a strong credential that helps both the official statisticians and the organisations hiring them to achieve benefits.

By encouraging their early-career official statisticians to earn OIC-CPOS certification, the organisations are expected to benefit from:

- · Increased productivity and decreased expenses: Employees with a strong certification are with better productivity skills (acclimating more quickly to new work environments, technologies and processes), thus enabling organisations to cut their expenses (as a result of fewer training hours)
- · Increased employee efficiencies: Certified official statisticians are more likely to perform better than those without certification and more suitable to handle difficult situations
- · Increased response time: Official statisticians with a certification background have a positive impact on their organisations' response times against the data demands originating from various stakeholders which results in a positive image of the organisations worked for

The official statisticians with OIC-CPOS certification are expected to benefit from:

- · Continuous education: During the certification process, candidates will study the recommended training materials which will contribute to updating their knowledge with respect to the current trends in official statistics. After getting certified, the training materials will act as a technical reference for the issues that the candidates come across in their professional careers.
- International recognition: Earning the OIC-CPOS certification shows the technical knowledge of the candidates and thus is a professional credential at the international level. Career advancement: Earning the OIC-CPOS certification will give the candidates a competitive advantage in their career paths. The National Statistics Offices (NSOs) and relevant departments under the line ministries of the OIC Member Countries and international organisations with a mandate on statistics like SESRIC are working on to provide additional benefits for the certified official statisticians.

As preparation for the Certification Examination (CertEx) under the OIC-CPOS, we recommend you the following training materials prepared by the OIC-CPOS Examination Committee (ExCom) to guide your study. Training materials for each statistical theme are classified under **five main statistical domains** (as per the Classification of Statistical Activities (CSA Rev I, Oct. 2009) taxonomy). The training materials made available in three official languages of the OIC (i.e., Arabic, English, and French – where applicable) include (i) **syllabuses** which can be used to have an overview of the content of the statistical themes; (ii) **textbooks** which are the main items for your self-study towards the OIC-CPOS CertEx; and (iii) **PPTs** and **other study materials** which are made available as additional sources besides the textbooks.


