The importance of transportation increases more than ever as it is an indispensable factor in enabling communication, trade and other forms of exchange among people. Thus, transportation plays an important part in economic growth and globalization. Gaining an understanding of where, when, and how people travel and how, when, and where commodities are transported is challenging given the diversity across the communities of all sizes, and this is only the first step in planning transportation infrastructure and services. In this regard, statistics on components of transportation, particularly motor vehicles, traffic volume and safety including road traffic accidents are critically important for countries to design and develop efficient transportation systems and infrastructures within a coherent and comprehensive policy framework while ensuring linkages with other policy areas and overall national development objectives and strategies.
