The statistical framework of Total Official Support for Sustainable Development - <u>TOSSD</u> - tracks all official resources flowing into developing countries for their sustainable development and private resources mobilised through official development finance interventions. It also measures contributions to International Public Goods – up to now not captured in development finance statistics. TOSSD is developed by an International Task Force comprised of provider and recipient countries, as well as multilateral organisations.
