

3. GAPS:



- A large deficit in information about job market
- The quality of training is unsatisfactory
- The training offer is quantitatively insufficient and qualitatively undiversified
- No existence of a structures for training of trainers.

4. THE NATIONAL STRATEGY OF VET

Objectifs:

- Strengthening and diversification of the training towards the modern economy: long-graduated training, creation of new institutions, certification courses.
- Establishment of a system for short skills training needed by the informal economy, rural economy and preparation for careers in lowskill.
- Amelioration of the governance : program contracts, results-based management
- 2020 : Over 10.000 of two years formations and over 20.000 of short training students.

- More than 20 private structures of training
- National Institut of VET Promotion
- Autonomous Fund of VET the Promotion
