## Active Labor Market Policies

## Public Works

- 197.182 participants, 310 million USD in 2013
- Target: long-term unemployed
- For adaptation to the working environment
- 9 months employment on public services
- Disabled, Convicts, Ex-convicts, ec
- 4.385 participants 4,75 million USD in 2013
- Funded through fees paid by employers not complying with quotas


## On the Job Trainings

- Especially for inexperienced youth
- 63.660 participants
- 50,7 million USD

## ¡ Objectives

- Provide experience in LM to the youth
- Develop skills needed by employers
- Connect participants to LM


## \# Duration

- up to 160 days,
- min 5 max 8 hours per day,
- max 45 hours \& 6 days per week,


## On-the-job Trainings

## ^ Participants

- Up to $10 \%$ of number of current employees
- Not ex-employees of the firm
- Stipend per day 25 TL (13 USD),
- Social security premiums paid
- No cost sharing by employers - all paid by İŞKUR
¡ Employers
- Can choose participants
- No obligation of post-program employment
- Cannot reduce number of employees throughout the program

## Social Assistance - Employment Relation

- General Directorate of Social Assistance (Ministry of Family and Social Policy) and Turkish Employment Agency (İ̧̧KUR) cooperate for 'Activating the Relation between Social Assistances and Employment'
- Social assistance applicants that are able to work are instantly registered into İŞKUR job-seekers database
- İŞKUR directs these people to ALMP and vacant jobs
- Integrated Social Assistance Services Information System
- A poverty inventory database
- Socio-economic data of 6,3 million households and 24 million citizens
- Information regarding the assistances and payments they receive from any public institution
- System's contribution to activation: Accurate data of citizen's for use in Activation Policies

## Subsidies

^ Social Security Contributions of employers (19\% of gross wages) for new workers
^ For workers in addition to current number of employees of the firm

- Duration of subsidy varies between 6 to 48 moths
