



- Be careful: keep questionnaire links




Executing phase

#### Strong declines noted for many themes, particularly:


- Agricultural statistics
- Balance of payments
- Environmental statistics
- Social statistics



- <u>Faster</u> delivery of data required
- Greater volume of data required an implicit objective of MEDSTAT III is more and better data
- Perhaps need to consider streamlining questionnaires







- Stage at which preliminary validation of data is conducted: checks for consistency and plausibility
- Made easier by in-built flagging system in questionnaires: partner countries see many problems upfront
- Questions drawn up: theme specific questionnaires sent out by Eurostat




## Monitoring and control phase
