


BASEIND (BAsic Social and Economic INDicators) DATABASE

- serves as the primary statistical source for publications of SESRIC,
- > is also available online, free of charge
- provides data for over 260 variables under 18 categories since 1970,
- is regularly updated and enriched on the basis of information collected from national and international organizations.

Established in 2011 as an apex entity to coordinate statistical activities at OIC level

The First and Second Sessions of the OIC-StatCom, organized succesfully with a greater interest from OIC member countries

Delegates of the NSOs of OIC Member Countries and international organisations including AITRS, COMCEC, EUROSTAT, IMF, OIC General Secretariat, PARIS21, UNESCWA, UNSD, and World Bank attended the Sessions

OIC Statistical Commission

Basic functions:

- Promote statistical data production and dissemination
- ensure coordination and cooperation
- raise the profile of statistics
- identify the statistical areas specific to the OIC Member States and develop methodology for this niche areas of statistics (e.g. Islamic finance, halal food industry and wakf)
- Facilitate active cooperation and coordination towards enhanching the role of national statistical systems

 deepening the expertise of the experts in the member countries


OIC-StatCaB Programme

- Development of tools for data dissemination (Inhouse SESRIC Motion Chart Module)




Short-term trainings organised for 2011-2012
